Requirements for Student Induction into TXA

The TXA Honor Society is open to students in environmental engineering, environmental science, and closely related disciplines. Inductees must meet the following requirements:

- Junior, senior, or graduate student in an academic curriculum or program approved by the National Council
- GPA \geq 3.5 for undergraduates, or GPA \geq 3.8 for graduate students
- Be of good moral character
- Be a Student Member of AAEEES
- Participates in student organization(s) related to environmental-related professions

Procedure for Inducting Students into TXA

A candidate must fill out an application form and provide three letters of recommendation from faculty members. The application package is forwarded with endorsement by the Faculty Advisor to the National Council. There is an application fee to cover the cost of the membership certificate, TXA lapel pin, and lifetime membership dues. The current application fee is \$100. Inductions will occur towards the end of the fall and spring semester of each academic year, and deadlines for applications are **November 1** and **March 1** for fall and spring, respectively. Upon approval by the National Council, a candidate is admitted to membership in TXA.
